

NOTES

1. Private LSLR work includes reconnection to existing curb stop and internal house plumbing.

2. Payment for private side LSLR shall be made as a lump sum payment for replacements up to 20 LF. Additional length paid on a LF basis.

3. Internal plumbing improvement include installation of a new backflow preventer, pressure regulator and expansion tank.

4. ACHD inspection includes all labor and costs for permit application; associated fees; final inspection, and any modifications, rework requried, or follow-up inspections required to rectify a failed inspection.

5. Private side restoration (aside from public sidewalk) is not included in the cost of the work.

6. Home owner and contractor should both initial each item indicated under Cost Proposal Documentation to document that the information was discussed and / or provided.

7. By submitting this Cost Proposal, contractor acknowledges that he has not received any downpayment from the home owner for replacement services or materials.
